Introduction 1000V insulated multi-socket clamp.

Text Multi-jaw pliers with superimposed hinges, eliminating the risk of misalignment and increasing the reliability of the jaws.
Sturdy shape, thanks to its curved head and slender form, creates good accessibility in tight spaces.
Self-locking on tubes and nuts for safe, energy-saving work.
Chrome-plated finish for high corrosion protection thanks to a succession of 5 baths.
Insulating reinforcements at the ends of the arms to protect against shocks.
Ergonomic design for powerful effort and secure clamping.
Protective ergot prevents pinching.

Color differentiation between the 2 insulating layers enables visual inspection of the entire tool to confirm its suitability for use in electrical environments, as recommended by UTE18-510 and IEC 60900.
WHEN THE ORANGE LAYER IS DAMAGED AND THE RED LAYER IS VISIBLE = DANGER.

- The thickness of the insulating layers is determined by the weight of the tools to ensure optimum resistance.
- Tools are designed to withstand extreme temperatures from -20 to +70°C.
- Each tool is tested to 10,000V AC and approved to 1000V AC for use on low-voltage

networks.

- Several checks at every stage of production, in addition to IEC 60900 standard checks.
