Double SAE recess: Allows the creation of male and female collars (single or double flare), ensuring total compatibility with brake fittings and hoses on the market.

Secure clamping system: Grooved dies provide a firm hold on the hose, preventing any slippage during the compression phase for a perfectly symmetrical collar.

Ergonomic, durable design

High-strength materials: Press and punches made of heat-treated steel to withstand repeated pressure without deformation, even on steel pipes.

Integrated pipe cutter: The set includes a pipe cutter (Ø3 to 30mm) with retractable

deburrer for clean cut preparation, a sine qua non for optimum sealing.

Compact "Easy-Work" format: thanks to its flat mounting, the tool can be stabilized in a vice (horizontally or vertically) for maximum working comfort when clamping.
